1. Join the worship broadcast 'logged on' through a personal YouTube Account at 8:25am, 10:55am, or 5 minutes prior to Special Service start time.
2. Be in **prayer** for the virtual worshipping community:
Example: Lord, please use this worship community to draw others into your beautiful presence.
3. At the beginning of the Broadcast, enter into the 'chat'
 - a. Good Morning, Friends! Then, introduce yourself, identifying yourself as the service's host.
 - b. Welcome individuals and/or families as they join the broadcast, and encourage fellow worshippers to greet one another.
 - c. Encourage worshippers to engage how they are led – sing when invited to sing, participate in responsive readings and unison prayers, read along in their personal Bibles, etc.
 - d. If you are hosting on a First Sunday, invite/remind worshippers to 'set their tables' with bread/crackers and juice/lemonade/water for everyone worshipping with them so they can join the celebration of the sacrament near the close of the service.
4. At the time of the Offering, post the following in the chat:
 - a. You can navigate to www.southshoreumc.com/online-giving to share your offering to God.
 - b. Please let South Shore know you worshipped with us today by emailing attendance@southshoreumc.com.
5. At the time of the Pastoral Prayer, post the following in the chat: You can share prayer requests with Pastor Sarah by emailing them to sarah@southshoreumc.com. Be sure to indicate your email if Pastor Sarah has your permission to share your request with SSUMC's Intercessory Prayer Team.
6. Following the Sermon, post the following in the chat:
 - a. What resonated with you most from the sermon today? (Share your own answer.)
 - b. How will you apply and/or engage that thought this week? (Share your own answer.)
 - c. 'Take attendance' by writing down the names of the persons that engaged with the chat, and submit the attendance, with the day's date and service time, to toni@southshoreumc.com.
7. Following the Benediction,
 - a. Thank everyone for joining the worship broadcast and engaging in the virtual worship community.
 - b. Wish them a great week and close out your broadcast browser.
