SSYouth Small Group Leaders join the Youth Director in the teaching and shepherding ministry of the Church. They are spiritual leaders with a passion for serving with students grades 6th through 12th (ages 12 to 18). Small Group leaders are committed to prayer, to reading and studying the Bible, to participating in worship and the Lord's Supper, and to serving in mission in the community. These holy habits are essential marks of discipleship.

Small Group Leaders are persons who are familiar with grace. They are comfortable in their own skin, acknowledge freely they do not have all the answers or need to know everything. They are good listeners who bring an atmosphere of grace with them into the meeting room. They pay attention to the people in the group and encourage everyone to participate. Small Group Leaders are aware of the gifts God has given them and look for gifts in others.

Small Group Leaders assist with supervision of students and facilitate activities throughout the SSYouth Gatherings. Small Group Leaders support their students in the SSYouth Ministry through prayer, accountability, authenticity, and faithful attendance at SSYouth.
