1. Arrive at 8:00am, 10:30am, or 30 minutes prior to Special Service start time.
1. Be in **prayer** for technology and the worshipping community:
Example: Lord, please use this media, lyrics, and liturgy to draw others into your beautiful presence.
2. If the presentation is not already loaded on the Presentation Computer, ask the Worship Leader and/or the Lead AV/Broadcast Team Member to load the presentation.
3. Cycle through the slides to familiarize yourself with the content of the worship service.
4. Familiarize yourself with the sermon transcript, paying special attention to the places in the sermon visuals are to be shared on the screen.
5. Check with the pastor, worship leader and/or Lead AV/Broadcast Team Member, for any last-minute additions.
6. Ask the worship leader and/or Lead AV/Broadcast Team Member for any needs.
7. **Pay attention** to the service and advance the slides on time, with great attention to accuracy.
8. If the Presentation and/or Presentation Computer freezes,
 - a. Immediately ask the Lead AV/Broadcast Team Member to 'blackout' the projection area so that the screen 'goes black' until able to bring the presentation back online.
 - b. Determine who in the AV/Broadcast Booth will walk to the piano to alert the worship leader that the presentation is currently unavailable.
9. At the conclusion of the last/closing worship service, ask the Lead AV/Broadcast Team Member to close out the presentation software and shut down the Presentation Computer.
