1. Be in **prayer** for technology:

- 2. Navigate to wix.com | Suggested Web Browser: Chrome
- 3. Login to Wix.com via credentials provided by the Church Office.
- 4. In the center of the screen in blue click Site Actions and choose Edit Site.
- 5. At the top of the webpage in blue it says "Page: Home"
 - a. Click *Home* to display a drop-down menu of the website's pages.
 - b. Navigate to desired page to edit by clicking on its name.
- 6. Double click to "activate editing" in the desired text box and begin editing the content as you would a Word Document.
- 7. At the top of the webpage select **Save** to periodically save your work.
- 8. You can *preview* your edits by selecting Preview at the top right of the screen.
- 9. Once you have completed all your edits and confirmed their accuracy, select **Publish** at the top right of the screen.
 - a. Close the Wix Website Editor tab on the web browser.
 - b. Open a new browser tab and navigate to www.southshoreumc.com and enjoy your completed edits!
